The Social Worker should be comfortable working in an interdisciplinary team setting using a holist treatment approach. The Social worker would work with people affected by emotional, mental, behavioral and medical issues. The Social Worker will assist each client cope with the challenges in their lives and live a productive healthier lifestyle based on their desired goal.

Job Responsibilities:

- Screen prospective clients.
- Provide timely psychosocial assessments and counseling.
- Assist clients in making the necessary adjustments to the lifestyle program and ensuring the necessary support system is in place while at Wildwood and after treatment.

- Able to utilize conventional treatment modalities (CBT, BSF, etc.) and encase them in Bible and Sprit of Prophecy principles.
- Develop and implement viable treatment plans with appropriate diagnosis.
- Perform follow up assessments and document as progress note.
- Implement treatment interventions including: group therapy, creative art therapy, outdoor activities.
- Monitor and evaluate clients' progress and modify treatment plans accordingly.
- Develop appropriate discharge plan.
- Provide timely follow up calls upon discharge.
- Serve mental health needs of outpatients and Wildwood staff as needed.
- Maintain accurate records and report on clients' status.
- Giving Lectures to Lifestyle Guests.
- Attend Providers meetings and all relevant meetings.
- Conduct staff in-services as needed.

Other Responsibilities:

There are many departments that work together to provide the services that are offered at the Wildwood Lifestyle Center. Workers may be asked to help out in another department as needed (housekeeping, kitchen, switchboard, transportation, etc.)
