

Nutritionist

To provide basic nutrition care for guests in partnership with medical providers and Diet Kitchen manager.

General Requirements:

- Member of the Seventh-Day Adventist Church, in good and regular standing.
- Has an understanding of the medical missionary work and desires to advance that work through their time, talents, and example.
- Agrees to live by God's principles in all areas of the Christian life (health, dress, entertainment, etc.) as taught in the Principle classes at the Wildwood Institute.
- Agrees to support the mission of the institution and to abide by its policies and guidelines as stipulated in the Institution's Policy Handbook.

Education & Qualifications:

- Completion of a Health educator course or equivalent.
- Understanding of God's principles of nutrition given to us in the Bible, Ministry of Healing, Counsels on Diets and Foods and other inspired counsels.

Skills/Experience

- Able to follow basic instructions and follow through with them.
- Computer, scheduling, & organizational skills.
- Reliable, dependable, neat, clean, and well groomed.
- Must be friendly, polite, and a team player.
- Speaks, read, and writes English fluently.
- Possesses coaching skills.
- Is alert in seeing and meeting guest's needs.
- Is enthusiastic about working with the guest and motivating them.

Job Responsibilities:

- Giving Lectures to Lifestyle Guests.
- Teach Cooking classes.
- Working with Medical Providers to provide nutritional guidance.
- Work with Providers on all specified meal plans for guests.
- Meet 1 or 2 times with each guest during the lifestyle session.

- Provide End of the Session reports.
- Produce research findings along with Spirit of Prophecy stating for guest or for Diet Kitchen purposes.
- Be available to work once or twice a month on a Sunday at the Lifestyle Desk.
(another day off in that week would be given in exchange)

Other Responsibilities:

There are many departments that work together to provide the services that are offered at the Wildwood Lifestyle Center. Workers may be asked to help out in another department as needed (housekeeping, kitchen, switchboard, transportation, etc.)
