- Conduct site surveys to assess and plan for the installation of telecom infrastructure.
- Collaborate with other technicians and engineers to implement network upgrades and expansions.
- Provide technical support and guidance to end-users and internal teams.
- Troubleshoot and resolve issues related to voice and data communication systems.
- Document, diagram and map all installation and maintenance activities accurately.
